## **Town of Speedway to freeze trash rates**

*Residents to see changes in future trash and recycling services*

**Speedway, Ind.** — The Town of Speedway has extended their contract with Ray's Trash Service to include a 10-year contract providing both solid waste and recycling services for residents of Speedway beginning early next year.

Current trash services involve two separate providers: Ray's Trash Service for solid waste and Republic for recycling, with rates totaling \$9.20 per month for Speedway citizens.

Under the extended contract with Ray's Trash Service – the largest independent recycling and waste disposal operation in the Indianapolis area since 1988 – residents will be provided with new 96-gallon bins for solid waste and recycling, whereas beforehand, the bins were only provided for recycling. Residents can also expect rates to be frozen at their existing levels for the life of the contract.

There is room in the contract for the town to ultimately provide households with additional services, like collection of yard waste, through Ray's Trash Service. This addition could slightly raise rates, but overall offers a cost-effective option for the future.

“Being able to freeze rates for current services over the next ten years will provide an incredible cost savings to our residents,” said Speedway Town Manager, Ian Nicolini. “We are also pleased to have flexibility to increase services over time, should it be necessary to meet the needs of our residents.”

The schedule of collection and frequency will not change under the contract. Speedway locals can expect weekly collection for solid waste and biweekly collection for recycling.
