The Holiday Pub2Pub 5K Run sponsored by Big Woods Speedway will occur at 4 P.M. on Saturday, November 26, 2016. The event will require some lane restrictions, limited street closures, and parking restrictions in town.

Main Street from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to Ford Street will be temporarily closed from 3:30 P.M. until 4:15 P.M. The street will reopen once all participants have started the race. In addition, Main Street will not be accessible from eastbound Crawfordsville Road beginning at 3:45 P.M. Restrictions will be lifted at approximately 5 P.M. During this time motorists may also experience delays at the intersection of Main Street and 16<sup>th</sup> Street while participants are crossing.

The east curb lane of northbound Lynhurst Drive from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to Crawfordsville Road will be closed for event participants beginning at 3:45 P.M. Lane restrictions in this area will be lifted at approximately 5 P.M. During this time motorists may also experience delays at the intersection of Crawfordsville Road and Lynhurst Drive, as well as the intersection of 16<sup>th</sup> Street and Lynhurst Drive.

The north curb lane for westbound 10<sup>th</sup> Street from Main Street to Lynhurst Drive will be closed for event participants beginning at 3:45 P.M. Lane restrictions in this area will be lifted at approximately 5 P.M.

Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted on Main Street for both the east and west sides of the street between 10<sup>th</sup> Street and Ford Street. Parking enforcement will not begin until 1 P.M. that day. After 1 P.M. any vehicle parked on Main Street between 10<sup>th</sup> Street and Ford Street will be towed at the owner's expense by the Speedway Police Department. Parking restrictions in this area will be lifted at approximately 4:30 P.M.
