## **RESOLUTION NO. 2012-07**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA APPROVING AWARD TO MACALLISTER POWER SYSTEMS FOR ACQUISITION OF A GENERATOR FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Town of Speedway, Indiana (the "Town") has heretofore established, constructed and financed a building and facilities for police and fire operations of the Town (the "Public Safety Building"), located generally at 1410 North Lynhurst Drive; and

WHEREAS, in October 2011, there was a serious interruption of electrical service at the Public Safety Building that required immediate assessment; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that the original generator installed at the Speedway Police Department was outdated and not able to meet the continued back-up generation needs; and

WHEREAS, the Town has since that time been renting a generator to meet emergency back-up generation needs; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is prudent to make provisions for the consistent and reliable back-up generation capacity of Police Department operations; and

WHEREAS, the Town issued a quote notice consistent with emergency provisions of state law; and

WHEREAS, MacAllister, Inc. was determined to be the vendor with the lowest bid that met the long-term and best interest of the Town and that the bid amount is <u>Thirty-Three</u> Thousand, One-Hundred Sixty-Four and 00/100 Dollars (\$33,164.00).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SPEEWAY, INDIANA:

- 1. The Town Council approves the acquisition of a new generator for the Police Department and related construction and installation costs and authorizes the Town Manager to take such actions as deemed necessary to effectuate the transaction.
- 2. The Town Council hereby approves the award to MacAllister Power Equipment. in the amount of \$33,164 funded from 2012 appropriations of the cumulative capital development fund..
- 3. Further expenses related to acquisition, installation, testing, and fuel shall be also be funded from 2012 Cumulative Capital Development Fund appropriation in a total amount not to exceed \$6,836.
