

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA AWARDED A CONTRACT TO ELECTRIC PLUS FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE ELECTRICAL SYSTEM AT THE POLICE AND FIRE BUILDING

WHEREAS, the Town of Speedway, Indiana (the "Town") operates and maintains facilities for police services, fire fighting and emergency medical response pursuant to Indiana and other applicable laws; and

WHEREAS, the police and fire facilities located at or about 1410 North Lynhurst Drive have been subject to serious service interruptions, brown-outs and related electrical issues at the facility; and

WHEREAS, a review of the facility and detailed electrical engineering analysis determined that aging facilities and declining conditions were leading to serious electrical service problems; and

WHEREAS, the Town issued a Request for Bid to numerous qualified electrical contractors and six (6) bids were received and opened in a public meeting on Tuesday, August 21, 2012; and

WHEREAS, there was a review of the bids and comparison made; and

WHEREAS, since the low-bidder did not submit a complete package as noted under the bid guidelines, Electric Plus was determined to be the contractor with the lowest bid that was both responsive and responsible and that the base and alternate bid amount is Fifty-Six Thousand, Thirty Dollars and 00/100 (\$56,030.00).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA:

1. The Council approves the upgrade of the electrical system at the police and fire facility.
2. The Town Council of the Town of Speedway, Indiana hereby approves the bid award to Electric Plus in the amount of \$ 56,030.00 to be funded from available funds including existing general obligation bond proceeds, to the extent such funds are available, and the cumulative capital development fund of the Town.
3. Further, an additional \$11,206.00 in similar funding shall be authorized as a contingency fund as needed in the course of the project for unforeseen circumstances but only to the extent that said repairs or changes are approved in advance by the Town.
4. The Town Manager is authorized to take the steps necessary to execute the contract and oversee the project.
