Modifications

- 1. Engineer's services are modified as follows:
 - A. Engineer will provide continued oversight on new water intake construction and also provide construction inspection and oversight for the Well Construction Project.
 - B. Engineer's fee assumes 35 weeks of construction activities at full-time oversight, plus 9 weeks of part-time oversight.
- 2. For the Additional Services or the modifications to services set forth above, Owner shall pay Engineer the following additional or modified compensation:
 - A. C.204.A.1 is revised to read as follows:
 - Resident Project Representative Services. For Resident Project Representative services under Paragraph A.1.05.A.2 of Exhibit A, an amount equal to the cumulative hours charged to the Project by each class of Engineer's employees times the Standard Hourly Rates for each applicable billing class for all services performed on the Project, plus related Reimbursable Expenses and Engineer's Consultant's charges, if any, not to exceed \$123,915.
 - B. The total fee for services authorized under the Owner-Engineer agreement dated November 29, 2010, Amendment 1, Amendment 2, Amendment 3, and this Amendment 4 is increased by \$26,805 from \$494,150 to \$520,955.
