### **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-10**

## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING WWTP LOCAL LIMITS STUDY

- **WHEREAS**, the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA) enforces federal law and regulations relating to the discharge and emissions of pollutants and has promulgated limits for discharges; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Town of Speedway, Indiana ("Speedway") owns and operates a Wastewater Treatment Plant utility ("WWTP") which is monitored by the EPA and has been issued a NPDES Permit No. IN0032972; and
- WHEREAS, Speedway has previously adopted a Sewer Use Ordinance containing local limits of permitted discharges of various chemicals and compounds by users of the WWTP as contained in Chapter 13.32 Industrial Wastes, Section 13.32.200 of the Speedway Code ("Local Limits"); and
- WHEREAS, federal regulations establishing categorical limits ("Categorical Limits") relating to the discharge of certain chemicals and compounds are codified in 40 CFR 433.15; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Town of Speedway has received a Memorandum from Environmental Engineers & Consultants, dated April 19, 2018, containing a technical evaluation of Speedway's Local Limits and a study in relation to the federal Categorical Limit and the EPA's recommendations ("Local Limits Study"); and
- **WHEREAS**, The Local Limits Study states that the Local Limits have proven to be adequately protective and do not need to be modified; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Speedway Town Council has reviewed the Local Limits Study and the analysis and recommendations and desires to formally adopt and accept the recommendations contained therein.

# NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA:

- SECTION 1: The Speedway Town Council hereby adopts and approves the Local Limits Study, dated April 19, 2018, and accepts the recommendations contained therein.
- SECTION 2. This resolution shall be in effect from and after its passage by the Council and compliance with Indiana Code 36-5-2-10.
