RESOLUTION NO. 2020-03

A RESOLUTION WAIVING UTILITY LATE FEES DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

- WHEREAS, the Indiana law provides that powers not specifically reserved for the State are delegated to the local government and may be regulated by a municipality [Home Rule], as delineated in I.C. 36-1-3; and
- WHEREAS, The Town of Speedway, Indiana, ("Speedway") owns and operates Speedway Utilities as provided for under Indiana law; and
- **WHEREAS,** Speedway Utilities is a municipally owned utility and governed by I. C. 8-1.5; and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to I. C. 8-1.5-3, the Speedway Town Council ("Council") controls Speedway Utilities, and sets reasonable rates and fees for its services and operation; and
- WHEREAS, the federal, state and local governments have declared states of emergency due to the Coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic, resulting in economic upheaval to the state and local economy, and exerting financial pressures on the many of the citizens of the Town of Speedway; and
- WHEREAS The Council, in recognition of the financial pressures due to the pandemic, and in an attempt to alleviate some of those exigencies, desire to waive any late fees normally accrued by customers of Speedway Utilities until the July 2020 billing cycle.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA:

- Section 1: The Council hereby waives any late fees accrued by customers of Speedway Utilities from April 1, 2020 through June 30, 2020.
- Section 2: The Council hereby declares this Resolution shall take effect in accordance with Indiana law.
