

**RESOLUTION 2022-11**

**SPEEDWAY TOWN COUNCIL**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING  
FUNDS FOR TRAIL/BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council (“Council”) for the Town of Speedway, Indiana (the “Town”) may legally expend funds and establish procedures not otherwise prohibited by Indiana law (Home Rule); and

**WHEREAS**, the Council recognizes salubrious benefits of pedestrian trails upon the health and well-being of the citizens of the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council further recognizes the diligent work of the Speedway Trails Association (“STA”), a non-profit corporation, in improving pedestrian trails in the Town and acknowledges their efforts in converting the abandoned B&O railroad corridor into a pedestrian trail; and


**WHEREAS**, the Council is aware that STA has procured a grant from the State of Indiana to construct a pedestrian bridge over 10<sup>th</sup> Street (the “Bridge”) in furtherance of their efforts for pedestrian trail conversion and construction; and


**WHEREAS**, The Council, to demonstrate their support of STA, desires to contribute to the enhancements for the Bridge in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000), for the benefit of the health and wellness of the citizens of the Town.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Speedway Town Council hereby reaffirms its support of the STA by providing funds in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000), for Bridge enhancements for the B&O pedestrian trail bridge over 10<sup>th</sup> Street for the benefit of the health and wellness of the citizens of the Town.


