

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF USED  
POLICE VEHICLES TO MSD WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP SCHOOLS POLICE DEPARTMENT

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Speedway, Indiana (the "Town") has vehicles utilized for police service; and

**WHEREAS**, certain vehicles have been determined to be surplus personal property by the Town's Chief of Police; and

**WHEREAS**, MSD Washington Township Schools Police Department desires to transfer the surplus vehicles to the use of MSD Washington Township Schools Police Department for service in the MSD Washington Township Schools District in Indianapolis, Indiana; and

**WHEREAS**, IC 36-1-11-8 provides for the exchange of surplus personal property between units of government upon terms and conditions agreed upon by the entities; and

**WHEREAS**, the surplus property set forth in Exhibit A has been determined to be of value to MSD Washington Township Schools Police Department and both governmental departments desire to transfer the property as set forth in Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Speedway, Indiana that:

Section I. The vehicles identified in Exhibit A have been designated as surplus personal property and the Town Council hereby approves.

Section II. The Town Council hereby approves the transfer of surplus property to MSD Washington Township Schools Police Department pursuant to the terms set forth in Exhibit A.

Section III. The Town Manager and President of the Town Council are hereby authorized to execute all bills of sale, or other documents necessary to affect the transfer of the surplus vehicles to MSD Washington Township Schools Police Department as set forth herein.

Section IV. This resolution shall be effective upon adoption,


