**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-17**

**A RESOLUTION REAFFIRMING RESOLUTION 2014-23 ESTABLISHING A SISTER CITY RELATIONSHIP WITH VARANO DE MELEGARI AND ESTABLISHING AN ADVISORY BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, the Indiana law provides that powers not specifically reserved for the State are delegated to the local government and may be regulated by a municipality [Home Rule], as delineated in I.C. 36-1-3; and

**WHEREAS**, The Town of Speedway, Indiana, ("Speedway") previously adopted Resolution 2014-23 establishing a sister city relationship with the Varano De Melegari, Italy ("Varano") to promote an exchange program for students Speedway Schools and those of Varano; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council for the Town desires to reaffirm its commitment to the sister city relationship with Varano, and to further establish an advisory board to assist in the operation and promotion of the sister city program.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY, INDIANA:**

Section 1: The Council hereby reaffirms its commitment to the sister city relationship, including an exchange program for high school students ("Program") with Varano as set forth in Resolution 2014-23.

Section 2: The Council hereby establishes the Varano Advisory Board ("Board") to be composed of five (5) members. Three (3) board members shall be appointed by the Town Council and two (2) members shall be appointed by the Speedway School Board. Each appointed member shall serve a term of four (4) years, but shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing authority.

Section 3: The Board shall oversee the finances of the Program and shall submit quarterly reports to the Town Council of receipts and expenditures, and submit an annual report to the Town Council and School Board.


Sections 4: The advisory Board shall work with Speedway Schools to identify and screen potential students for participation in the Program and assist with fundraising for the expenses related to students' participation in the Program.




