

Minutes of the Meeting  
Of the  
Board of Metropolitan Fire Commissioners

The Board of Metropolitan Fire Commissioners for the Town of Speedway held its regular meeting on Monday June 14, 2010 at 4:10 p.m, in the Town Hall Auditorium, 1450 N. Lynhurst Drive, Speedway Indiana. Those presents were Commissioners, Joe Olofson, Tom Wilson, Jay Adams and Chief Watson.

There were no petitions from the audience.

Discussion was held regarding the two pending openings on the Fire Department. Chief Watson advised the hiring process will start June 21<sup>st</sup> with 131 Applicants. Chief Watson advised around 41 applicants will pass the written general aptitude test and physical agility test, and be interviewed by the Battalion Chief, an Officer and First Class Firefighter. Out of those 41 Chief Watson will interview and give Pits Agility Test. Chief Watson advised approximately 20 will be eligible for hiring and will be listed from highest to lowest scores resulting from the accumulation of the written test, oral interview, physical agility and the Chief's interview. The list of 20 will then be presented to the Fire Commission for certification. The certification be in effect for 18 months. Each candidate will be advised of their placement on the eligibility list.

Chief Watson advised of a Battalion Chief Opening and that he would like to have this vacancy filled as soon as possible due to overtime to fill this vacant position. The only candidates that can apply for this position are captains only, there are currently two captains. Chief Watson advised one captain has verbally told him told that he will not be posting for the position. If the other captain is interested he will still be required to take a written test and oral interview for the position.

Chief Watson advised that if the captain is promoted to Battalion Chief that will open up a Captains position and a Lieutenants position. Chief Watson stated that he believes six candidates will apply for the Captains position and 12 to 16 will apply for the Lieutenants position. He would like these open positions filled as quickly as possible.

Chief Watson stated he is still searching for a location where the two probationary firefighters will attend a fire academy.

Chief Watson advised he will be appointing a fireman to engineer. This is not a merit rank.

Terry Payne will be retiring effective July 2, 2010.




