

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE THROWING OR DUMPING OF DEBRIS OF
ALL KINDS IN, UPON, OR BY THE SIDE OF ANY PUBLIC HIGH*
WAY, ROAD, STREET OR ALLEY, AND FIXING A PENALTY
THEREFOR

SECTION I

BE IT ORDAINED By the BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY,
INDIANA, THAT whoever puts, throws, dumps or leaves any tin cans, old
iron, machinery, brush, boxes ashes, vegetable matter, dirt, filth,
garbage, rubbish and debris of any kind or character whatsoever, in,
upon, or within the limits of any Public Highway, road, street or
alley, is guilty of an unlawful act, and upon conviction thereof shall
be fined in any sum not to exceed Ten (\$10.00) Dollars.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effec
from and after its passage and posting a true copy thereof in one public place
in each ward or District in the Town of Speedway, Indiana, for ten (10) days.
