

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MARSHAL OF THE TOWN OF SPEEDWAY,  
INDIANA, TO APPOINT DEPUTY MARSHALS

SECTION I

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the town of Speedway, Indiana, that the Marshal of said Town be and he is hereby authorized to appoint four deputy marshals, who, in executing the orders of said Board and in enforcing the laws of this state shall possess the powers and be subject to the liabilities of said marshal. Said deputies shall serve one year from the date of their appointment and shall be subject to the orders of said marshal who may discharge them, any or all, at any time.

SECTION II

Be it further ordained that the Marshal of said Town be and he is hereby authorized to appoint seventy-five, more or less, deputy marshals who in executing the orders of said board and in enforcing the laws of this state shall possess the powers and be subject to the liabilities of said marshal provided for in this section shall serve during the Speedway races May 30, 1929. Said deputy marshals shall be subject to the orders of said marshal who may discharge any or all of them at any time.

SECTION III

Be it further ordained that whereas an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this ordinance the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
