Notice of filing with the public service commission of petition for approval of purchase of water system and issuance of bonds, and of date and place at hearing thereon.
Notice is hereby given to the citizens and taxpayers of the town of Speedway that pursuant to an ordinance of the board of trustees of said town adopted October 30, 1929, the undersigned clerk of said town has filed with the public service commission of Indiana the petition of the town of Speedway praying the approval of the said commission for a contract between said town and Speedway Water Company set out in said ordinance, whereby said company agrees to sell and said town agrees to buy the water plant and system of said company in the town of Speedway and all property used and useful in connection therewith, as described in said contract for the sum of seventy-two thousand dollars (\$72,000), payable in Water Revenue Serial 6 per cent coupon bonds of said town, at par, and also praying the approval of the said commission for the issuance and delivery of said bonds, as said purchase price; and that said commission has set down the matters and things contained in said petition for hearing at its rooms in the Statehouse, Indianapolis, Ind., on November 21, 1929, at 10 a. m.

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION
You are hereby notified that on the 23rd day of August, 1929, between the hours of 6 o'clock and 6 p. m. on said day, a special election will be held under the provisions of an act of the general assembly of the state of Indiana approved April 19, 1905 (acts of 1905, page 383, et seq.) as amended by act approved March 13, 1915 (acts of 1915, page 689, et seq.) and according to the provisions of the laws of Indiana pertaining thereto, at which election declaratory resolution No. 1, 1929, adopted by the board of trustees of the town of Speedway on the 22d day of August, 1929, will be submitted to the qualified voters of the town of Speedway for approval or rejection.
And which said declaratory resolution declares in favor of the town of Speedway entering upon a policy of purchasing, maintaining and operating a sewer system for said town of Speedway and its inhabitants.
And which said declaratory resolution further declares in favor of purchasing from the Speedway Realty Company the sewer system now owned by the town of Speedway and adjacent territory, including all sewers, franchises, rights, easements, appurtenances and other property and rights now used and enjoyed by said Speedway Realty Company, in maintaining and operating said sewer system; and including the purchase of approximately seventeen (17) acres of land and surrounding the mouth of said sewer, all for the purchase price of forty thousand (\$40,000) dollars.
And which said declaratory resolution further declares in favor of entering into a contract with the Speedway Realty Company for such purchase, in the form set out in said declaratory resolution.
You are notified that said declaratory resolution and copies thereof are on file and will continuously be on file in the office of the clerk of the town of Speedway for inspection and examination by the public.
Such election will be held under and by the authority of a general ordinance passed by the board of trustees of the town of Speedway on the 22d day of August, 1929, and said election will be held at Deeler Hodgson Garage being in the established voting precinct for said town of Speedway in Marion county, state of Indiana, on said day.
