CODE ENFORCEMENT CORNER

PARKING COMPLAINTS!!!!

There have been several complaints coming in to the Speedway Code Enforcement Office regarding parking issues throughout the town. These issues range from residents parking in their yards, parking the wrong way on the street and storing abandoned vehicles on their property. There are only three exceptions to parking on your lawn in the Town of Speedway; race events, loading and unloading, and washing your vehicle. If you are using your yard for a parking lot at any time other than the listed exceptions, this is not acceptable and the registered owner will be subject to a fine of \$50.00.

The second complaint received by our office pertains to residents or visitors parking the wrong way on public streets. This is also not permissible under Speedway Municipal Code, and can become hazardous since you are pulling away from a curb and travelling into oncoming traffic that has the right of way. The fine for this violation is also \$50.00

Finally, our office has received several complaints regarding abandoned vehicles. Residents may not park or store any vehicle on their property that is not properly registered, is unlicensed or has not moved for 20 days. If you have a vehicle that meets any of these criteria please make the appropriate corrections to avoid the vehicle being tagged and eventually towed from your property at the owner's expense. If you need to store a car, please put it in your garage or find another location to store it other than your property.

Please be respectful to your neighbors and community by abiding by our parking restrictions. Let's keep our community clean and safe so it remains a great place to live and raise a family. A clean and healthy property helps improve safety by eliminating hazardous conditions. It also reduces blight that often fosters criminal activity and helps to maintain and increase property values for our residents.
