This year will mark our **28th Annual Phone-A-Thon**, with student volunteers from Speedway High School calling Speedway residents with an opportunity to help fund scholarships that will be awarded to members of the Speedway High School Class of 2018.

Because of the generosity of past donors, our organization has been able to award 1149 scholarships totaling **\$1,046,200** since its beginning in 1989. Of the 36 scholarships awarded through Scholarships for Speedway to the Class of 2017, **15** were funded by these **Phone-A-Thon** donations. Our goal is to award even more scholarships this year and we can do that with your help!

Our History:

A small, dedicated group of our citizens set out to provide scholarships for Speedway students. The results:

1989 - They pooled their own funds to establish a local scholarship program and awarded one scholarship of \$500 to graduating senior, Heather Davidson.

*1990 - Five \$1000 scholarships were awarded to graduating seniors with the help of additional community members and we were able to establish our Endowment Fund with help from the **Speedway Parent-Teacher Association**.*

*1991 - The first annual **Phone-A-Thon** raised enough funds to award sixteen \$1000 scholarships.*

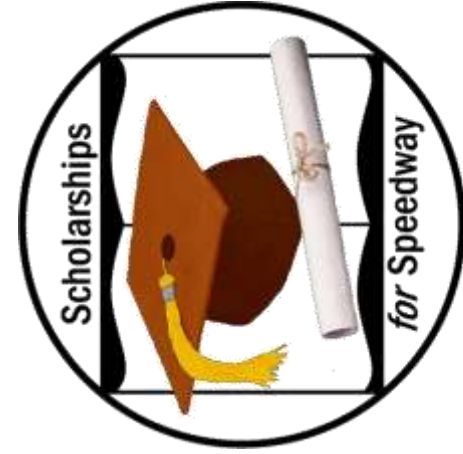
*1993 and '94 - The **Indianapolis Motor Speedway**, along with numerous local businesses, joined us in our "**Racing for Education**" program to build up our Endowment Fund, used to support the continuing education of Speedway students working toward their first undergraduate degree.*

2013 - A reorganization of our program took place and we are now strictly a local organization continuing the same mission.

*Today - As of August 2017, we have awarded 1149 scholarships amounting to **\$1,046,200** in aid to Speedway graduates.*

Who We Are:

We reorganized in 2013 and are now registered with the State of Indiana as **Scholarships for Speedway, Inc. (SFS)**. We are recognized by the IRS as a 501(c)3 public charity.

Our Purpose:

Originally founded in 1989 as a non-profit community organization, the current SFS program continues to work to assist Speedway students meet the cost of higher education.

Our Goals:

To provide first-year scholarship aid to as many graduating Speedway High School (SHS) seniors as possible and to provide scholarship opportunities to continuing education students from Speedway working toward their first undergraduate degree.

Supported By:

Voluntary contributions come from supporters who feel a strong Speedway connection such as residents, families, businesses, clubs, civic groups, alumni, former students, and former residents.

Memorial gifts may be one-time general donations or to establish a continuing scholarship through annual grants. You can also establish an endowment through SFS to administer a designated scholarship.

Scholarship Application:

A scholarship application form is available to graduating SHS seniors in the high school guidance office or from our website by selecting **Scholarships for Speedway, Inc.** on the "**Community**" tab found at www.SpeedwaySchools.org.

Instructions on applying for a **Continuing Education Scholarship** will be provided in the Speedway Town Press in May of each year and on our website.
