INDIANAPOLIS MOTOR SPEEDWAY HOSTS 22nd INDY SPORTS CORP CORPORATE CHALLENGE

Up to 150 companies from Central Indiana are expected to vie for titles in the 2018 Indiana Sports Corp Corporate Challenge sponsored by Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield. Preliminary events will be conducted on August 18, August 23 and for the fourth-consecutive year, the main event will be at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway on August 25th. The Indy Sports Corp Corporate Challenge is a fun-filled community event that emphasizes healthy lifestyles, friendly competition and company camaraderie.

The competition offers something for each member of the company: distance runs, sprints, a fitness walk, tug-of-war, and field activities (called “*Good Sport Events*”) such as basketball shootout, football accuracy throw, golf chipping challenge and soccer shootout, to name a few.

The Speedway Police Department reminds residents that on August 25th there will be a heavy increase in traffic near the Indianapolis Motor Speedway. Streets that could be affected by this traffic include 16th Street, 25th Street, 30th Street, Crawfordsville Road, Auburn Street and Winton Avenue. Participants will be parking in Indianapolis Motor Speedway Lot #2 to the west of the Speedway American Legion Post 500 and Lot #7 off of 30th Street. Police officers will be directing traffic in those areas to help ensure safety, with minimal delays for both participants and residents.
