The Hops and Flip Flops Craft Beer Festival will occur on Saturday, August 18, 2018 which will require street closures on Gilman Street and Allison Way. In addition to the craft beer festival there will be a 5K run earlier that day. The 5K run will only require temporary lane restrictions and a limited number of full street closures throughout town.

5K Run Lane Restrictions and Street Closures:

The northbound lane of Main Street from 10th Street to 16th Street will be closed for event participants beginning at 8:30 A.M. Lane restrictions in this area will be lifted at approximately 10:15 A.M.

The curb lane for westbound 10th Street from Allison Way to Lynhurst Drive will be closed for event participants beginning at 8:30 A.M. Lane restrictions in this area will be lifted at approximately 10:15 A.M.

The east curb lane of northbound Lynhurst Drive from 10th Street to Crawfordsville Road will be closed for event participants beginning at 9 A.M. Lane restrictions in this area will be lifted at approximately 9:30 A.M.

Main Street will not be accessible from eastbound Crawfordsville Road from approximately 8:30 A.M. until the end of the event.

Hops and Flip Flops Craft Beer Festival Street Closures:

Gilman Street and Allison Way between 10th Street and Main Street will be closed for all but emergency traffic and event participants beginning at 8:30 A.M. on Saturday, August 18, 2018. Gilman Street and Allison Way will reopen in the area of the closure at approximately 6 P.M. that same day. All other businesses along Gilman Street will be accessible during this time.
