Town of Speedway to hold annual ‘State of the Town’ *Feb. 19 community briefing offers look at site of future town hall*

(*Speedway, Ind.*) The Town of Speedway will hold its annual State of the Town on Tuesday, Feb. 19 at 6:30 p.m. at the future site of its town hall and police station.

The annual community briefing is free and open to the public. It will feature remarks from local officials on 2018 milestones and 2019 initiatives. Guests also will have an opportunity to explore the town hall and police station before renovations begin later this year.

The event will be taped for broadcast on the Town’s local access channel, SCTV. SCTV is Channel 28 for Comcast subscribers and Channel 99 for AT&T U-verse subscribers.

In Nov. 2018, the town purchased the 40,000 sq. ft. building at 5300 Crawfordsville Rd., also known known as the PNC building, marking a critical step in moving town offices to a centralized location to better serve citizens and operate more efficiently.

The new town hall will incorporate the offices from the current town hall, the town annex administrative offices, the Speedway Police Department, and several school administrative offices. It will also offer substantial free parking.

Town officials anticipate the new town hall will open to the public in summer 2020.
