The month of May has arrived and it is time to remind residents of the Main Street parking restrictions that the Speedway Police Department will enforce during the 500-Mile Race events at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway.

During Qualification weekend three (3) hour parking will be enforced on both sides of Main Street between 10<sup>th</sup> Street and 16<sup>th</sup> Street from Friday, May 17, starting at 12:00 AM until Sunday, May 19, at 11:59 PM.

During the weekend of the 500 Mile Race three (3) hour parking will be enforced on both sides of Main Street between 10<sup>th</sup> Street and 16<sup>th</sup> Street, from Friday, May 24, starting at 12:00 AM until Saturday, May 25, at 11:59 PM.

There shall be no parking on Main Street between 10<sup>th</sup> Street and 16<sup>th</sup> Street on Race Day, Sunday, May 26, starting at 12:00 AM. In addition, there shall be no parking on Gilman Street or Allison Way (including those areas designated for parallel parking on the north and east sides of the roadway) on Race Day, Sunday, May 26, starting at 12:00 AM.

Also, keep in mind that **should there be a rain out of the Race, it may become necessary to enforce parking restrictions beyond these times.** We apologize for this inconvenience and appreciate your continued cooperation now and in the future.
