Town of Speedway's Clerk-Treasurer Retires

(*Speedway, Ind.*) Monty Combs, Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Speedway, has officially retired from his position effective January 31st, 2020.

Monty began as Clerk-Treasurer in November 2013, replacing the Town's previous Clerk-Treasurer mid-term before being re-elected twice by the residents of Speedway. He stated he will be retiring due to personal reasons.

Monty has created a sturdy foundation for the Town of Speedway the last six years by serving with integrity and dedication, leading the town to increase and maintain an excellent "A+ credit rating". During his time, the town has also received positive feedback from the Indiana State Board of Accounts, the state agency which audits all government entities. In his resignation letter Combs stated, "The office is very proud of the big finish which was the recent 2018 Audit by the State Board of Accounts with no findings. In the last six years, we stopped two fraudsters that were criminally charged and all fraud for those who were stealing taxpayer money. The financial situation is solid due to the continued hard work of the staff."

As with all vacated elected positions, state law requires a replacement be elected by the local Precinct Committee Members of the same political party of the resigning official. This process is administered by the bipartisan Marion County Election Board.
