Specifically, the Town encourages businesses and organizations in the Town of Speedway to follow the following recommendations by Governor Holcomb:

*Non-essential gatherings must be limited to no more than 250 people. This includes any event or gathering of people who are in one room or a single space at the same time, such as cafeterias, churches, stadiums, meeting and conference rooms, auditoriums and the like. This guidance applies to professional, social, community and similar other gatherings. Detailed guidance is posted on the Indiana State Department of Health website – <https://www.in.gov/isdh>*

*Child care and adult day care facilities should institute social distancing and minimize large gatherings. Temporary suspension of operations should be done in consultation with the Family and Social Services and ISDH in the instance of documented community spread.*

*Individuals over 60 years of age or those with a known underlying health issue such as cardiovascular disease, diabetes or chronic respiratory disease should limit their public exposure. Whenever possible, friends and family should arrange to provide food and other essential items.*

Town services including Public Safety (Police and Fire), Water and Sewer Services, Parks, etc. will continue to operate as usual. All Town offices including the Speedway Town Hall, Speedway Town Annex, Police & Fire Departments, and Library will remain open for business during normal business hours. However, please tune into specific websites for those entities as they are subject to change.

All town employees will continue to function in their roles to serve residents and businesses. Police and Fire Department personnel have been and will continue to be trained and equipped for individuals who potentially have or have been exposed to the COVID-19 Virus. Residents are encouraged to make payment of water/sewer bills through the US Postal Mail Service, the blue payment box located at Town Hall, and via online payment options. Residents are encouraged to only make payments in person at the Town Hall if the other options are not possible.
