Summary of Temporary Street Restrictions

- Main Street from 14th Street to Gilman Street – All Lanes (4:00 P.M.–9:30 P.M.)
- Main Street from Gilman Street to 10th Street – All Lanes (6:55 P.M.–7:05 P.M.)
- 10th Street from Main Street to Lynhurst Drive – Westbound Lane Only (6:55 P.M.– 7:25 P.M.)
- Lynhurst Drive from 10th Street to 16th Street – 1 Northbound Lane (7:00 P.M.– 7:30 P.M.)
- 16th Street from Lynhurst Drive to Main Street – Eastbound Lane (7:05 P.M.–7:40 P.M.)
- Main Street from 16th Street to Crawfordsville Road – Southbound Lane (7:10 P.M.– 7:45 P.M.)
- Crawfordsville Road from Auburn Street to Polco Street – Eastbound Lanes (7:10 P.M.– 7:45 P.M.)
- Polco Street from 16th Street to 10th Street – Southbound Lane (7:10 P.M.–7:55 P.M.)
- 10th Street from Polco Street to Allison Way – Westbound Lane Only (7:10 P.M.– 7:55 P.M.)
- Allison Way from 10th Street to Gilman Street – Northbound Lane Only (7:10 P.M.– 8:00 P.M.)
- Gilman Street from Allison Way to Main Street – Westbound Lane only (7:10 P.M.– 8:00 P.M.)

Parking Restrictions:

Temporary “No Parking” signs will be posted on Main Street from Gilman Street to 14th Street on Thursday, September 17, 2020, at 8:00 A.M. After 4:00 P.M. that day, any vehicle parked on Main Street between Gilman Street and 14th Street may be towed at the owner’s expense by the Speedway Police Department.

Parking restrictions will be lifted at the conclusion of the race.
