PLANT OPERATOR JOB DESCRIPTION

Definition

Responsible for the proper and efficient operation of the wastewater treatment plant on an assigned shift.

- Immediately supervised by the Chief Operator.
- Ultimately responsible to the Superintendent

Environmental Conditions

- Work outside in all kinds of weather conditions.
- Exposed to odors, wastewaters, sludges, and certain chemicals.

Essential Job Functions & Abilities

May include, but are not exclusively limited to, the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Ability to tolerate unpleasant odors, wastewaters, and sludges.
- Check various operational parameters in the plant; report process and equipment status to supervisor; make adjustments as directed.

- Sampling at various plant locations which involves climbing up and down stairs.
- Reading and recording data.
- Pumping sludge.
- Cleaning and painting of tanks, buildings, pipes, etc.
- Monitor gauges and plant equipment.
- Monitor plant operations using a computer.
- Perform basic laboratory analysis.
- General housekeeping.
- Maintain operator logs and data sheets.
- Perform minor maintenance tasks.
- Ability to recognize abnormalities in plant operations and equipment and make appropriate adjustments as needed.
- Ability to follow instructions.
- Ability to communicate both verbally and in writing.

Qualifications

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Valid Indiana Driver's License
- Indiana Wastewater Operator Certification preferred but not required. Preference is given to those candidates who are interested in working towards obtaining certification.
