

MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING OF August 10, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Council President David Lindsey at 7:00 PM. Other Councilors present were Eileen Fisher, Vince Noblet, Gary Raikes, and Gary Pedigo.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by President Lindsey.

The Minutes from the July 13th, 2020 Town Council meeting were approved as presented.

Guest Presentation from U.S. Senator Todd Young's Office

Monica Kozlowski from Senator Young's office provided an update on various constituent services their office provides and a potential Coronavirus relief package.

Appointment to Speedway Cable Advisory Commission

Council President Lindsey opened nominations. Councilor Fisher nominated Geoff Smith. Councilor Raikes made a motion to close the nominations, which received a second from Councilor Noblet. A vote was taken and the above nominated was appointed by a vote of five to zero.

Ordinance 1328 – An Ordinance Establishing a Special Event Permit

Councilor Noblet made a motion to approve the ordinance, which received a second by Councilor Fisher. There were no public comments or questions. The ordinance was approved by a vote of five to zero.

Ordinance 1329 – An Ordinance Amending Town Code of Speedway Chapter 7.05, Relating to Animal Licenses

Clerk-Treasurer Blasdel advised that further changes to the ordinance may be needed and recommended waiting to hear an amended ordinance at a future meeting. Council agreed by concurrence and no action was taken on the ordinance.

Approval of HR Consulting, On-Call and Monthly Retainer Agreement

Councilor Raikes made a motion to approve the agreement, which received a second from Councilor Noblet. There were no public comments or questions. The agreement was approved by a vote of five to zero.

APPROVAL OF CLAIMS & UTILITY ADJUSTMENTS:

Claims identified in the Accounts Payable Vouchers for the period of July 11th to August 7th, 2020 were submitted to the Council by the Clerk-Treasurer for review and approval. Councilor Raikes made a motion to approve the claims, which received a second by Councilor Fisher. There were no public comments or questions. The motion was approved by a vote of five to zero.


