

MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING OF May 11, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Council President David Lindsey at 7:00 PM. Other Councilors present were Eileen Fisher, Gary Raikes, Vince Noblet, and Dan Jensen.

The Minutes from the April 13th, 2020 Town Council meeting were approved as presented.

Approval of Date Change for Run 317 Speedway Race – September 17, 2020

Approval of Opening for Farmers Market on Main St
