

MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING OF MARCH 22, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Council President Vince Noblet at 7:01 PM. Other Councilors present were David Lindsey, Eileen Fisher, Gary Raikes, and Gary Pedigo.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by President Noblet.

The Minutes from the March 8th, 2021 Town Council meeting were approved as presented.

Brief Comments from Parker Adams – President, Speedway District Local 416

Parker Adams offered comments appreciating the open communication between the fire union and town leadership, especially as it pertained to the public safety contract, during the challenging 2020 year.

Request for Special Event on April 4, 2021 for Speedway Lions Club

Councilor Lindsey made a motion to approve the special event (Easter Bunny Parade), which received a second from Councilor Raikes. The special event was approved by a vote of five to zero.

Resolution 2021-02 – A Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Speedway, Indiana, Approving a Resolution of the Town of Speedway Redevelopment Commission, Making Amendments to the Declaratory Resolution for the Consolidated Redevelopment Area and Matters Related Thereto

Councilor Pedigo made a motion to approve the resolution, which received a second from Councilor Fisher. The resolution was approved by a vote of five to zero.

Ordinance 1339 – An Ordinance Authorizing the Issuance of the Town of Speedway, Indiana Taxable Economic Development Revenue Bonds, Series 2021 (1300 Block Project), and the Lending of the Proceeds Thereof to the Borrower Thereof and Authorizing and Approving Actions in Respect Thereto (First Reading)

Councilor Raikes made a motion to approve the ordinance, which received a second from Councilor Lindsey. A vote was taken, and the ordinance was approved by a vote of five to zero.

Consideration of Contract for Cleaning Services for 5300 Crawfordsville Road

Councilor Fisher made a motion to approve the contract with Shalnelson, LLC, which received a second from Councilor Pedigo. A vote was taken, and the resolution was approved by a vote of five to zero.

Consideration of Contract for Managed IT Services for the Town of Speedway, Indiana

Councilor Raikes made a motion to approve the contract with Sondhi Solutions through the end of 2021, which received a second from Councilor Pedigo. A vote was taken, and the resolution was approved by a vote of five to zero.

Consideration of Encroachment License Agreement to Locate Structures in Right-of-Way (Dawson's on Main)

Councilor Raikes made a motion to approve the agreement, which received a second from Councilor Fisher. A vote was taken, and the agreement was approved by a vote of five to zero.

Approval of Claims & Utility Adjustments:

Claims identified in the Accounts Payable Vouchers for the period of March 6th, 2021 through March 19th, 2021, were submitted to the Council by the Clerk-Treasurer for review and approval. Councilor Lindsey made a motion to approve the claims, which received a second from Councilor Pedigo. There were no public comments or questions. The motion was approved by a vote of five to zero.

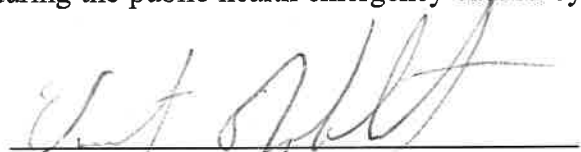
