

MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING OF OCTOBER 11, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Council President Vince Noblet at 7:00 PM. Other Councilors present were Eileen Fisher, Gary Raikes, and Gary Pedigo.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council President Vince Noblet.

The Minutes from the September 27, 2021 Town Council meeting were approved as presented.

Approval of Funding Commitment Letter and Grant Application Submittal for an Indianapolis Metropolitan Planning Organization Grant for Improvements to Crawfordsville Road and Lynhurst Drive

Councilor Raikes made a motion to approve the funding commitment letter, which received a second from Councilor Fisher. A vote was taken, and the funding commitment letter was approved by a vote of four to zero.

Approval of Funding Commitment Letter and Grant Application Submittal for an Indianapolis Metropolitan Planning Organization Grant for Improvements to the Crawfordsville Road Corridor/Intersection of Cunningham Road

Councilor Raikes made a motion to approve the funding commitment letter, which received a second from Councilor Fisher. A vote was taken, and the funding commitment letter was approved by a vote of four to zero.

Ordinance 1348 – Approval of 2022 Budget for The Civil Town of Speedway (Second Reading)

Councilor Fisher made a motion to approve the ordinance, which received a second from Councilor Pedigo. Council President Noblet asked for comment at 7:11. No public comment was provided. A vote was taken, and the ordinance was approved on second reading by a vote of four to zero.

Ordinance 1349 – Approval of 2022 Budget for The School Town of Speedway (Second Reading)

Councilor Pedigo made a motion to approve the ordinance, which received a second from Councilor Fisher. Council President Noblet asked for comment at 7:12. No public comment was provided. A vote was taken, and the ordinance was approved on second reading by a vote of four to zero.

Ordinance 1350 – Approval of 2022 Budget for The Speedway Public Library (Second Reading)

Councilor Fisher made a motion to approve the ordinance, which received a second from Councilor Raikes. Council President Noblet asked for comment at 7:13. No public comment was provided. A vote was taken, and the ordinance was approved on second reading by a vote of four to zero.

Ordinance 1351 – Approval of 2022 Budget for The Speedway Public Transportation (Second Reading)

Councilor Fisher made a motion to approve the ordinance, which received a second from Councilor Pedigo. Council President Noblet asked for comment at 7:14. No public

comment was provided. A vote was taken, and the ordinance was approved on second reading by a vote of four to zero.

Request for Temporary Road Closure of Main Street for Light The Night Event on December 1st, 2021

Councilor Fisher made a motion to approve the road closure, which received a second from Councilor Pedigo. A vote was taken, and the road closure was approved by a vote of four to zero.

Approval of Claims & Utility Adjustments:

Claims identified in the Accounts Payable Vouchers for the period of September 25, 2021, through October 8, 2021, were submitted to the Council by the Clerk-Treasurer for review and approval. Councilor Pedigo made a motion to approve the claims, which received a second from Councilor Raikes. There were no public comments or questions. The motion was approved by a vote of five to zero.

The Utility Adjustments report for the period of September 25, 2021, through October 8, 2021, were submitted to the Council by the Clerk-Treasurer for review and approval. Councilor Lindsey made a motion to approve the adjustments as submitted, which received a second from Councilor Fisher. The motion was approved by a vote of five to zero.


