

Water Plant Operator

We are hiring for a second shift Water Plant Operator. This position performs a variety of skilled, technical, and maintenance work, including daily inspections, adjusting chemical feeds, and monitoring water operations.

Schedule: 5 PM – 1 AM – Monday – Friday

What you get to do:

- Properly operate a 3 MGD surface water treatment plant, 10 MGD groundwater treatment plant, 13 wells, 2 elevated and 1 ground storage tanks, and sludge basin.
- Perform daily walk through inspection of treatment plant and equipment
- Monitor and record plant operations
- Collect samples and perform analysis at various points in the treatment process
- Adjusts chemical feed systems and pumpage
- Calibrate chemical feed systems and on-line water quality analyzers
- Drain sludge and coordinate with sludge haulers
- Monitor inventory of chemicals, supplies, instruments, and/or other necessary supplies
- Know and understand drinking water regulations
- Respond to customer issues
- Maintain MSDS book
- Respond to after-hours requests, as necessary

Experience Requirements:

- High School or GED
- Must have valid state driver's licenses
- Preferred some college with math, science, or engineering background
- 5+ years experience relating to: water treatment, laboratory testing, pumping operations, chemical feed systems, SCADA operations, on-line instrumentation, basic maintenance
- WT-5 and WT-3 water operator's licenses from the State of Indiana Department of Environmental Management or ability to obtain licenses within 1 year of employment
- DS-L and A-SO water operator's licenses from the State of Indiana Department of Environmental Management or ability to obtain licenses.
- Any equivalent combination of education and experience
- Frequently lift up to 50 lbs and occasionally lift up to 100 lbs

Skills:

- Ability to understand the water treatment process and impacts
- Knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions.
- Operating knowledge and use of motorized vehicles and equipment, including large equipment like dump trucks, utility trucks, saws, compressors, pumps, etc.
