



# PRESS RELEASE

The 500 Festival Mini-Marathon will be held on Saturday, May 6, 2023. The event will start in downtown Indianapolis and proceed to Michigan Street, west on Michigan Street to Holt Road, north on Holt Road to 10<sup>th</sup> Street, west on 10<sup>th</sup> Street to Ford Street, west on Ford Street to Main Street, north on Main Street to 16<sup>th</sup> Street and east on 16<sup>th</sup> Street. Runners will enter the track at Gate #2, complete a lap and exit onto 16<sup>th</sup> Street from Gate #4. Runners will then proceed east on 16<sup>th</sup> Street, south on Olin Avenue, east on 10<sup>th</sup> Street, south on White River Parkway and east on New York Street to the finish line at Military Park.

It will become necessary to block the following streets in the Town of Speedway from approximately 7:30 A.M. until 12:00 P.M. or until the race is clear of Town.

**Street Closing/Restrictions in the Speedway area:**

**Crawfordsville Road from Lynhurst Drive to the 16<sup>th</sup> Street Roundabout:** Restricted to local traffic only. No traffic will be allowed on the 16<sup>th</sup> Street Roundabout.

**Main Street from 16<sup>th</sup> Street to 10<sup>th</sup> Street:** Closed for all but emergency traffic. NO ON-STREET PARKING. Parking is available on adjacent lots & streets.

**16<sup>th</sup> Street from Lynhurst Drive to Main Street:** Restricted to local traffic only. No traffic will be allowed eastbound on 16<sup>th</sup> Street from Main Street.

**10<sup>th</sup> Street from Lynhurst Drive to Main Street:** Restricted to local traffic only. No traffic will be allowed eastbound on 10<sup>th</sup> Street from Main Street.

**10<sup>th</sup> Street from Olin Avenue to Main Street:** Closed.

**16<sup>th</sup> Street from Livingston Avenue to Main Street:** Closed.

**Olin Avenue from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to 16<sup>th</sup> Street:** Closed.

**Polco Street from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to 16<sup>th</sup> Street:** Closed.

**Cossell Road from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to Grande Avenue:** Local traffic only.

All streets intersecting Main Street between 10<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed at Main Street. In addition, Gilman Street, Allison Way, and Ford Street from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to Main Street will be closed.

**Parking Restrictions:**

Temporary “No Parking” signs will be posted on Main Street for both the east and west sides of the street on Friday May 5, 2023, at 4:00 P.M. Although the signs will be posted by 4:00 P.M. on Friday, May 5, 2023, parking enforcement will not begin until 3:00 A.M. on Saturday, May 6, 2023.

After 3:00 A.M. on Saturday, May 6, 2023, any vehicle parked on Main Street between 10<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> Streets will be towed at the owner’s expense by the Speedway Police Department.

Parking restrictions will be lifted at the conclusion of the race.
